ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Separate sealed bids for the construction of the **Greensville County -Low Ground Mitigation Bank** will be received by Greensville County at the Greensville County Government Building (GCGB) located at 1781 Greensville County Circle, Emporia, Virginia prior to **3:00 pm local time on May 23, 2019**. At which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The principle work to be performed under this contract consists of, but not limited to improvement of the following:

- Construction of a wetland mitigation bank by converting existing agricultural fields (farmland) into wetlands. This contract will be only for Areas 1 and 2 as designated on Drawings.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis, as indicated in the Bid Form. The Engineer for this project is B&B Consultants, Inc.

Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, printed Bidding Documents will be sent.
