The Electoral Board of Greensville County and the Registrar met at 6:00 p.m. on October 30, 2018 in the Board Room of the Greensville County Government Building for a mandatory training meeting with the Officers of Election for the General & Special Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018.

Mr. Harrell advised there has been some interest in the "24.2-604.3 Election day page program; high school students" at Precinct 202-Brink. After discussion, it was agreed the 16 year old participant could participate in cooperation with high school authorities with a letter from his teacher and/or principal.

Mr. Harrell welcomed new members of Officers of Election, namely: Ann Thomas and Tony Conwell.

Everyone present was given an opportunity to view the new, durable, light-weight, heavy-duty folding Voting Booth which will be available at each polling place. Each Voting Booth is the perfect height to be used with the corrugated, plastic privacy screen.

Those present also viewed a POWERpoint presentation entitled "Preparing for Election Day".

Chairman Jones stated boxed lunches, to include ham or turkey sub sandwiches from SUBWAY, would be provided to each Officer of Election by the County on Election Day and delivered by the Farm Bureau Women's Committee.

Mr. Harrell provided each chief a sample Dominion Voting Machine CHECKLIST, Statement of Results, Quick Referenced Election Guide, What-If, and new provisional ballot forms. He further advised there is a new password for the voting machine.

Mr. Harrell asked how many absentee applications have been requested and how many absentee ballots have been received to-date. Mrs. Conwell replied that 164 absentee applications have been completed and received and 118 absentee ballots have been received as of today's date.

Mr. Harrell advised that the election day boxes would be packed and ready for the Chief of each Voting Precinct to pick up on Monday, November 5, 2018 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon. Mrs. Richardson agreed to be present at the Registrar's Office to assist with the election day boxes.

No further business, the meeting was adjourned.
