Chairman Wiley called the meeting to order at 1:00 P.M with Supervisor Ferguson being absent at this time.


In Re: VRA Loan Resolution #14-112

Mr. Whittington addressed the Board of Supervisors stating that Staff wanted to borrow \$1.2 million to buy the old Perdue Building. He stated that there were arrangements made with Toll Brothers and Quick 180 but the deal was not ready at this point where Staff was comfortable in borrowing money. He also stated that it would have to be the Water and Sewer Authority to borrow the money and loan it to the County. He then stated that if the deal did not come together, then Staff would have borrowed \$1.2 million for nothing and Staff was requesting that no action be taken on the Resolution and to not go into the Water and Sewer Authority meeting.

There was a consensus among the Board of Supervisors to not take action regarding Resolution #14-112 and Resolution #WS-14-29.
