ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Separate sealed bids for the **construction of the Jarratt Water Treatment Plant Sludge Handling Upgrade** will be received by the Greensville County Water & Sewer Authority (Authority) at the Greensville County Government Building (GCGB), located at 1781 Greensville County Circle, Emporia, Virginia prior to **2:00 pm local time** on **May 5, 2016**. At that time the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Proposal must be submitted to in sealed envelopes. The exterior of the envelope must be clearly marked as “**Bid for the Jarratt Water Treatment Plant Sludge Handling Upgrade**”. The exterior of the envelope must also be clearly marked with the respondent’s name, mailing address, and phone number.

The principle work to be performed under this contract consist of, but not limited to improvement of the following:

- 160 LF of 6” DIP gravity sewer
- 1 EA pump station
- 108 LF of 3” HDPE directional drilled
- 165 LF of 2” force main in casing
- 2,092 LF of 2” SDR 21 PVC force main
- 6 EA sewer air release valve assemblies
- 1 EA 3-way plug valve.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis, with additive alternate bid items as indicated in the Bid Form.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:15 am -5:00 pm and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below. Bidding Documents may also be examined at the GCGB, address listed above, on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 9 am – 4 pm.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above. Bidding Documents are available as portable document format (PDF) files for a non-refundable charge of \$50 per set, payable to “B & B Consultants, Inc.”, non-refundable. Alternatively, printed Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office either via in-person pick-up or via mail, upon Issuing Office’s receipt of payment for the Bidding Documents. The non-refundable cost of printed Bidding Documents is \$150 per set, payable to “B & B Consultants, Inc.”, non-refundable. Upon Issuing Office’s receipt of payment, printed Bidding Documents will be sent. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder’s date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A pre-bid conference will be held **at 10:00 a.m.** local time on **April 26, 2016** at the GCGB; address listed above. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions for Bidders.

A performance bond and payment bond, each in the amount of one hundred (100) percent of the Contract Price, with a corporate surety approved by the Owner, will be required for the faithful performance of the contract.

Evidence of proper registration with the Virginia State Registration Board of Contractors, pursuant to Chapter 7 of Title 54 of the Code of Virginia, must be submitted with each bid.

Greensville County reserves the right to reject any and all proposals received, to negotiate with the low bidder, and/or to re-advertise the project for bids. The County is an equal opportunity provider and employer.
