

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Separate sealed bids for the construction of the I-95/Exit 4 Potable Water Storage Project will be received by the Greensville County Water and Sewer Authority prior to 2:00 PM, local prevailing time on February 23, 2016, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. The Authority offices are located in the Greensville County Government Building at 1781 Greensville County Circle, Emporia, VA 23847.

The project consists of providing and installing a new 10,000 gallon horizontal steel potable water storage tank and associated work at the Authority's I-95/Exit 4 Potable Water Storage Facility (Skippers). The Project includes, but is not limited to:

- Install new piping, valves, and other appurtenances to facilitate connections between the new and existing facilities;
- Install a new aboveground 10,000 gallon horizontal steel potable water storage tank.
- (Additive Bid Items) Depending on available funding – paint interior and exterior of existing above ground 10,000 gallon horizontal potable water storage tank; and furnish and install new pump controls and float switch on new tank.
