

Assessments

Any Adjustment Request **MUST** be made at the time of filing your Personal Property - By May 1st

- wrecked vehicles, junk/salvage vehicles, high mileage
- Proof - oil change receipts, recent state inspection slips, repair bills, police accident reports

ALL Adjustment Requests (along with Personal Property lists) **MUST** be filed by May 1st in order for your request to be processed for the upcoming tax bill. Any Adjustment Request received after May 1st will **NOT** be considered.

LATE FILING PENALTY - Personal Property Filing Form must be filed with the Commissioner of the Revenue's Office **EACH YEAR** by May 1st to avoid a late filing penalty (10% or \$10.00 whichever is greater). Sign and return the filing form by May 1st to avoid penalty.

Personal Property Credit applications for certain disabled veterans **MUST** be filled out and brought into the Commissioner of the Revenue's Office with proper documentation to be qualified for the credit. The applications will be mailed out September 1st and are due on or before November 1st. Any applications received after the due date will not be accepted.
