

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM FOUR MONTH FLOW MONITORING STUDY

Greensville County Water & Sewer Authority (Authority) is going to conduct a four month study of sanitary sewer flows in the Authority's Jarratt Collection System.

The Authority is requesting proposals from qualified engineering firms to: (1) Review collection system drawings and the pump station run time report. (2) Work with our staff in developing multiple monitoring locations for four flow monitors and one rain gauge. (3) Review the data being collected via a cloud based data delivery system. (4) Develop a monthly report and make recommendations to relocate monitoring equipment, if necessary. (5) Develop a final report detailing the results of the four month study. (6) The final report will include recommendations to reduce the amount of storm water entering the sanitary sewer system. The report may include recommendations for additional monitoring, the need to smoke test or camera identified sections of leaking sewer lines. The report will include cost estimates for the recommendations. (7) The report shall be submitted within 60 days of completing flow data collection.

The Water & Sewer Authority will supply the flow monitoring and data collection equipment. The Authority plans to lease the flow, data collection equipment and services via a separate contract. The installation, calibration and maintenance of the monitoring and data collection equipment will be the responsibility of the selected equipment supplier.

Proposals must be submitted to the attention of Glen Gibson at the Greensville County Administrative Building, 1781 Greensville County Circle Emporia, VA 23847. Responses must be clearly marked on the exterior of the package "Engineering Proposal for Wastewater Flow Monitoring Study". Proposals must be received prior to 2:00 pm on October 4, 2016. Proposals received after the stated date and time will be returned unopened.
