

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

The Greensville County Water & Sewer Authority is hereby requesting proposals for the hourly services of an experienced Industrial Controls Electrician. The quote for services will be valid for a three (3) year period beginning on, or about, March 1, 2016 and is a non-exclusive proposal. The selected contractor will respond to calls, for electrical problems, process control issues and or emergencies at any of the Authority's water or wastewater facilities. The contractor's services may also be used on new electrical projects the Authority plans and implements.

Contractors must be located within 50 miles of the Greensville County Government Center and willing to respond to electrical service requests within 1 hour. A minimum of 10 years of experience working with water and sewer utilities is required. Contractor must have a general understanding of water/wastewater treatment plant, potable/raw water distribution and sanitary sewer system operations. The Authority has elected to secure this service via competitive negotiation. The Authority took this action by passing Resolution WS-16-23. Accordingly, the cost of the service is only one of the selection criteria. All proposals will be evaluated by a selection committee. Interviews will be conducted with the highest ranked companies.

Proposals must be received prior to 2:00 pm, Tuesday, February 9, 2016. Proposal received after the stated date and time will be returned unopened. Proposals must be submitted to the attention of Glen Gibson, at the Greensville County Government Building, 1781 Greensville County Circle, Emporia VA 23847. Proposals must be submitted on the Authority's proposal form. Proposals received after the stated date and time will not be considered.
