

Request for Proposals

The Greenville County Water & Sewer Authority (Authority) is currently soliciting proposals from qualified engineering firms to design improvements for the I-95, Exit 4 water system. The improvements are part of the Authority's plan to convert the I-95, Exit 4 water system from a non-community to a community water system.

Proposals must be submitted to the attention of Glen Gibson at the Greenville County Government Building, 1781 Greenville County Circle, Emporia, VA 23847. Responses must be clearly marked on the exterior of the package as **"Engineering Proposal for I-95, Exit 4 Community Water System Conversion"**. Proposals must be received prior to 2:00 p.m. on April 19, 2016. Proposals received after the stated date and time will not be considered.

The design must be in conformance with all regulatory requirements and permitting agencies. Additionally, the engineering firm will be required to: (1) generate plans and specifications to be used for the construction of the project, (2) secure any required regulatory permits, (3) produce bid documents for public advertisement, (4) assist the Authority with a contractor selection, and (5) provide final inspection(s) of the work and supply Certificate(s) of Completion for the work.
