At the Regular Meeting of the Greensville County Board of Supervisors, held on Tuesday, July 5, 2016, with Closed Session beginning at 4:30 P.M. and Regular Session beginning at 6:00 P.M., at the Greensville County Government Building, 1781 Greensville County Circle, Emporia, Virginia.

Chairman Wiley called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

In Re: Closed Session

Mr. Whittington, County Administrator, stated that Staff recommended the Board go into Closed Session, Section 2.2-3711 (a) 1) Personnel, 5) Business and/or Industry and 7) Legal Matters.

Supervisor Ferguson moved, seconded by Supervisor Bryant, to go into Closed Session, as recommended by Staff. Voting aye: Supervisors Bryant, Ferguson, Lee, and Chairman Wiley.

In Re: Regular Session

Mr. Whittington stated that Staff recommended the Board of Supervisors return to Regular Session.

Supervisor Ferguson moved, seconded by Supervisor Bryant, to go into Regular Session. Voting aye: Supervisors Bryant, Ferguson, Lee and Chairman Wiley.

In Re: Certification of Closed Meeting – Resolution #17-01

Supervisor Bryant moved, seconded by Supervisor Lee, to adopt the following Resolution. A roll call vote was taken, as follows: Supervisor Bryant, aye; Supervisor Ferguson, ay, Supervisor Lee, aye and Chairman Wiley, aye.

RESOLUTION #17-01

CERTIFICATION OF CLOSED MEETING

WHEREAS, the Greensville County Board of Supervisors has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provision of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712 of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by the Greensville County Board of Supervisors that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Greensville County Board of Supervisors hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification resolution applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered by the Greensville County Board of Supervisors.

In Re: Approval of Agenda

Mr. Whittington stated that Staff recommended approval of the agenda with no added items.

Supervisor Ferguson moved, seconded by Supervisor Bryant, to approve the Agenda as submitted. Voting aye: Supervisors Bryant, Ferguson, Lee and Chairman Wiley.

In Re: Approval of Consent Agenda

Mr. Whittington stated that Staff recommended approval of the Consent Agenda.

Supervisor Ferguson moved, seconded by Supervisor Lee, to approve the Consent Agenda containing the following items. Voting aye: Supervisors Bryant, Ferguson, Lee and Chairman Wiley.

Approval of minutes from the meeting of June 20, 2016.

Budgetary Matters consisting of the following: Fund #001 – Re-Appropriations Resolution #17-02, in the amount of \$10,928.00 and Fund #018 – Re-Appropriations, in the amount of \$239.11, both of which are incorporated herein by reference.

In Re: Citizens Comments

Mr. Whittington addressed the public stating that anyone wishing to address the Board of Supervisors to please come forward and state their name and address for the record. There was no one.

In Re: Golden Leaf Commons

Mr. Jim Saunders, Chairperson of the YMCA Board of Directors, stated that the YMCA had requested a waiver of the rental fees of the Golden Leaf Commons for July 19, 2016, for the 15th Anniversary celebration. He stated that at the last meeting, the request was denied and no one from the YMCA was in attendance at that meeting to speak on their behalf. He also requested if the Board of Supervisors would reconsider and approve the request for the waiver of the rental fees. Mr. Saunders noted a few statistics of the YMCA as follows:

- The YMCA serves 2,417 individuals in the community, and
- The average daily usage of the YMCA was 244 people, and
- The Child Program has 80 attendance on a daily basis, and
- The diversity of the YMCA was as good as any organization in the community with a makeup 60% African American, 39% Caucasian and 1% Hispanic, and
- The budget was made up of 50% membership fees and 30% based on program held by the YMCA and 20% based on contributions; and
- The YMCA was a Non-Profit Organization

Mr. Saunders stated that the YMCA appreciated what was done for it over the years with the annual budget. He stated that they were looking forward to using the Golden Leaf Commons on July 19 and would be using the Golden Leaf Commons, whether the request was approved or denied.

Mr. Whittington stated that the Greenville County Board of Supervisors recognized the fine work done by the YMCA. He stated that Kristen and the YMCA had been an instrumental part of the Child Care Center and the planning. He also stated that the contributions of the YMCA to the community were just indescribable. He further stated that Board of Supervisors had to take

in to account the other community organizations for the Board's consideration as well. He then stated that there were other community organizations that used the Golden Leaf Commons and paid the full fee. Mr. Whittington then named a few of those organizations. He stated that the Board of Supervisors were very concerned about the ability to tell all of the organizations that they would have to pay, if the Board allowed the YMCA not to pay. He also stated that should a time of exempting all of those fees for community organizations come about then the costs for operating the Commons would be passed on to the Greensville County taxpayers. Mr. Whittington then stated that Staff did not support the waiver of the rental fees.

Mr. Saunders stated that based on some of the organizations that were mentioned, many of those organizations used the facility to raise funds. He stated that their event was for the YMCA to give back to their fundraisers and to show their appreciation.

Supervisor Ferguson stated that he had asked Mr. Saunders to come back before the Board of Supervisors to make the request again and in the meantime, he had spoken with Mrs. Parson and Mr. Whittington to make sure that a waiver had never been given to anyone. He stated that the sad thing about the situation was that once the Board of Supervisors started approving the requests for different organizations, how they would not be able to stop approving the requests. He then stated that it would only be fair to all organizations not to allow a break in the rental fees.

Mr. Saunders stated that as Chairperson of the YMCA, he would like to invite the Board of Supervisors, as well as the City of Emporia, to take a day and tour the YMCA to learn about its day to day operations.

Supervisor Ferguson stated that the Board of Supervisors had taken a tour of the YMCA about four to five years ago and thanked Mr. Saunders for extending the invitation. He also stated that he hoped Mr. Saunders understood that the Board of Supervisors could not approve the request at this time.

In Re: Agreement between the Department of Rail and Transportation and Greensville County

Mrs. Parson stated that the Master Agreement between the Virginia Department of Rail and Transportation and Greensville County set out the terms and conditions for the receipt of grant funds by Greensville County for the upcoming Public Transportation System. She also stated that by signing the agreement, the County was agreeing to adhere to the grant administration requirements, maintain an asset inventory list and do the performance recording as required by the Department of Rail and Transportation. She further stated that the Board of Supervisor would later be receiving a Project Agreement which was specific to the County's projects and that everyone who received grant funds were required to submit the Master Agreement. She then stated that Staff was recommending approval of the agreement.

Supervisor Ferguson moved, seconded by Supervisor Lee, to approve the Master Agreement with the Department of Rail and Transportation. Voting aye: Supervisors Bryant, Ferguson, Lee and Chairman Wiley.

In Re: Boards and Commissions Appointments

DIRECTOR'S COMMENTS

The applicant wishes to establish a child day care in her residence located at 674 Riverview Road. The subject property is located in a Urban Service District area within the Land Use Plans Urban Service District.

The Urban Service District was established on the land use plan for the purpose of identifying that general area within the County where major urban-type development is to be both expected and encouraged. Land Uses within the Urban Service District are expected to fall within a full range of residential, commercial, and industrial development.

The subject property is located within an area of the County zoned R1-B, Residential. The actual character of the area matches the Zoning Ordinance's definitions of the R1-B Zoning District found in Section 2-3-1 of the Zoning Ordinance. While the Comprehensive Plan does not specifically address this activity, it is an activity that could benefit citizens of Greenville County. Being a use designated as requiring a Special Use Permit, it is an approvable use provided appropriate safeguards are imposed to protect the health, safety, and general welfare concerns of the community.

Such safeguards are presented as conditions which, if imposed, will govern the subject activity. Conditions 1, 3 and 10 are standard conditions. Condition number 9 is a condition which ties the activity to the standard vesting standards contained in the Code of Virginia and the Greenville County Zoning Ordinance.

Condition number 2 is imposed because the rules and regulations of the Department of Social Services and the Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code could have an impact on this request.

Condition numbers 5, 6, 7, and 8 are imposed to ensure that there is no conflict with the normal traffic patterns that exist on Riverview Road. Because this activity is being established within the residence of the applicant, it will allow the surrounding area to maintain its residential qualities, while having minimal impact upon surrounding properties.



Staff's recommendation is to approve with the following conditions:

1. A Special Use Permit is granted to Mrs. April W. Clarke, hereinafter operator, for a child day care to be established at her residence known as 674 Riverview Road.
2. At all times be in compliance with all local, state, and federal rules, regulations, laws, and statutes, and ordinances with special attention given to the following:
 - a. The Virginia Department of Social Services Rules and Regulations
 - b. The Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code
3. The operator is responsible for securing all permits for all aspects of the activity and is responsible for adhering to all terms and conditions imposed by this permit.
4. Provide to the Planning Department documentation from the Department of Social Services(If permit is required), and the Greenville County Building Department that the operator has satisfied each department's requirements to operate a child day care.

5. No parking is to occur within the right-of-way of any public road.
6. Children may not be dropped off or picked up within the right-of-way of any public road, with the exception of the children that will board or exit the school bus.
7. Adult supervision shall be provided for all children that will be boarding or exiting the school bus at operator's residence.
8. A sign no larger than four (4) square feet which identifies the property may be installed upon the property. The sign must be set back a minimum of five feet (5') from the road right-of-way.
9. Utilizing the permit issuance date as the annual date, if the day care is not established within two years or is not utilized for a two year period, the activity will be deemed abandoned and this permit terminated.
10. Failure to abide by the above conditions may result in the immediate revocation of the Special Use Permit.

**RESOLUTION # 17-09
APPROVING THE REALIGNMENT
OF ROGERS ROAD (SR 605)**

The Board of Supervisors of Greensville County, Virginia (the “Board”), in a regular meeting on the 18th day of July, 2016, adopted the following:

WHEREAS, as a part of the Dominion Power Greensville Power Plant, a portion of Rogers Road (SR 605) is being realigned (the “Realignment”) approximately as shown on that certain plat entitled “Compiled Plat Showing Rogers Road Realignment and Drainage Easement across the lands of Virginia Electric and Power Company”, prepared by Timmons Group attached hereto as Exhibit A (the “Realignment Plat”); and

WHEREAS, as part of the Realignment, a portion Rogers Road will be abandoned (the “Abandoned Portion”) in accordance with applicable state law requirements and as more particularly shown on the Realignment Plat (the “Abandonment”); and

WHEREAS, once the Commissioner of Highways has abandoned the Abandoned Portion and deemed its use to be no longer necessary, if the Commissioner of Highways does not prepare and execute a deed conveying all right, title and interest to the Abandoned Portion to Virginia Electric and Power Company (“DVP”), then the County Administrator shall execute and deliver a deed quitclaiming any interest of the County in the Abandoned Portion to DVP (the “Quitclaim Deed”); and

WHEREAS, as part of the Realignment, DVP will dedicate a new right of way (the “Right of Way”) to the Board as more particularly shown on the Realignment Plat (the “Dedication”); and

WHEREAS, as part of the Realignment, DVP will dedicate a drainage easement (the "Drainage Easement") to the Board as more particularly shown on the Realignment Plat, and shall maintain such Drainage Easement unless such maintenance responsibilities are subsequently undertaken by the Virginia Department of Transportation ("VDOT") but in no instance shall the County be responsible for and does not assume any maintenance responsibilities for the Drainage Easement; and

WHEREAS, in order to complete the Realignment, the Board must temporarily close Rogers Road (SR 605) to allow construction of the relocated portion of Rogers Road, and the demolition of existing Rogers Road within the construction limits, beginning at the Greensville County line and ending approximately 0.56 mile east of the County line on Rogers Road, as more particularly shown on the plans entitled "**Virginia Electric and Power Company - Brunswick County Power Station – Volume IV – Stormwater, Erosion Control & Rogers Road Realignment with latest revision**", dated September 24, 2015, and prepared by Timmons Group (the "Plans"); and

WHEREAS, the Board anticipates that the Temporary Road Closure will occur for no more than 90 consecutive days, commencing on or about July 20, 2016 to allow for roadway demolition and construction in connection with the Realignment; and

WHEREAS, VDOT has reviewed and supports the proposed temporary closure of Rogers Road (SR605) in connection with the Realignment, subject to DVP complying with the following conditions:

1. Compliance with the VDOT-approved Maintenance of Traffic Plan;

2. Construction plans for the Realignment shall be approved by VDOT;
and
3. The Right of Way shall be dedicated from DVP to the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, for purposes of public necessity, convenience and general welfare, the Board hereby approves (1) the Realignment, (2) the Abandonment, (3) the Quitclaim Deed, (4) the Right of Way and Dedication, (5) the Drainage Easement, and (6) the temporary closure of Rogers Road (State Route 605) as described above in accordance with the above-stated conditions;

AND RESOLVED THAT, the County Administrator shall be authorized to execute any and all documents to effectuate the matters contained in this resolution.







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Solar Farm Initiative
July 8, 2016

Recently the Virginia General Assembly exempted the taxation of solar farms by local governments in Virginia by 80%. This financial incentive mandated on localities by the General Assembly is generating a great deal of interest in the development of solar farms. There has been a substantial development of solar farms in North Carolina during the past few years and that development can be used as an example of what could happen in Greensville County.

The County staff believes that the County may be unprepared to appropriately regulate the development of solar farms. The Staff concerns appear below:

1. The site should be returned to natural, preexisting condition if abandoned or at end of useful life. Should the County require a letter of credit, bond or other financial guarantee that will ensure the financial resources exist to remove solar farm?
2. Solar farms have a less than desirable appearance from public rights of way and adjacent properties. How solar farms are best regulated?
 - a. Use permit or development plan
 - b. Set backs from property lines, residences
 - c. Buffers
3. Should there be a minimum size for a solar farm?
4. Any concerns regarding preservation of farm land? Agriculture and forestry are still the cornerstones of the local economy.
5. Impact on comprehensive plan?
6. How should solar farms be regulated by existing environmental laws and policies?
 - a. E&S
 - b. Wetlands
 - c. Storm water
 - d. Historic resources

The Staff is seeking the direction of the Board of Supervisors through this initiative to further investigate the development of solar farms and to make recommendations as to how to appropriately regulate the development of solar farms.
