

**Assessments**

**ANY ADJUSTMENT REQUEST MUST BE MADE AT THE TIME OF FILING YOUR PERSONAL PROPERTY (By May 1<sup>st</sup>)(i.e. junk vehicle, wrecked vehicle, high mileage). Proof of such adjustment MUST be submitted with your request. Example of such proof are: oil change receipt, last state inspection slip, repair bill or police accident report. FILE BY MAY 1<sup>ST</sup> IN ORDER FOR YOUR REQUEST TO BE PROCESSED FOR THE UPCOMING TAX BILL. ANY FILING AFTER MAY 1<sup>ST</sup> WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

**LATE FILING PENALTY \$\$\$\$\$\$\$- PERSONAL PROPERTY FILING FORM must be filed with the Commissioner of the Revenue by May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year to avoid a penalty of 10% or \$10.00, whichever is greater. Just sign and return filing form by May 1<sup>st</sup> to avoid penalty.**

**Personal Property Credit applications for certain disabled veterans must be filled out and brought into the Commissioner of the Revenue's Office with proper documentation to be qualified for the credit. The credit applications will be mailed out September 1<sup>st</sup> and are due to be in the Commissioner's office on or before November 1<sup>st</sup>. Any applications received after the due date will not be accepted.**
